Senate Bill No. 2200 - Department of Public Instruction - Senate Action

This bill provides a \$2 million general fund appropriation to the Department of Public Instruction for joint powers agreement incentives.

This bill also provides a \$10 million general fund appropriation to the Department of Public Instruction for school maintenance and improvements contingent upon an ending balance exceeding \$30 million.

Senate Bill No. 2200 - Board for Career and Technical Education - Senate Action

This bill provides a \$2 million general fund appropriation to the State Board for Career and Technical Education for area career and technology centers and career and technical education programs.
