


### **Other Sections in Bill**

Grandstand project - Section 3 declares the \$18 million appropriation for the grandstand project an emergency.

### Agency Funding

Continuing Appropriations State Fair operating fund - North Dakota Century Code Section 4-02.1-15 provides all income, fees, rents, interest, and any other money received by the State Fair Association are to be deposited in a special fund, and those funds are appropriated as a standing appropriation for the purposes provided in the chapter.
