This bill would increase the tax on "liquors, liquers, and cordials" by 50¢ per gallon. Based on an estimated 707,004 gallons on which the state treasurer collected tax in 1963, the annual increase in state general fund revenue would be \$353,502 per year or \$707,004 for the 1965-1967 biennium.
