
There is no information available from which the loss in revenue from this bill can be estimated.

The exemption for sales in interstate commerce that are deducted by retailers who deliver the purchased items across state lines is such that if a 2% tax could have been collected on them it would have amounted to at least \$1,600,000 in sales taxes per year. This bill will simply permit those sales to be exempt even though the items purchased are not delivered by the retailers across the state line to the customer and there will therefore be no affect on revenue by the sale of those items. But some additional sales exempt under this bill will also be made which will cause a revenue loss, but we have no information on which to make an estimate of that loss.
