~~In our opinion, the language in Senate Bill No. 255 does not require a fiscal note. Chapter 52-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code permits the election (or contract) for coverage of employing units that are not compelled to be covered. At present, and even if the bill is passed, governmental units will still be exempt from the unemployment insurance coverage.~~

The only effect the passage of Senate Bill No. 255 has is to change the method of paying contributions by a governmental unit if it elects or contracts for this coverage.

The bill proposes that if we pay out X number of dollars in benefits chargeable to employment with a governmental unit which has elected coverage, that unit would reimburse the agency for exactly that amount paid out.
