The above projections of revenue required some arbitrary estimating of income because adequate data is not available.

The estimated distribution in April, 1971, from the state general fund to the county treasurers of \$20,500,000.00 is the estimated amount of taxes that will be levied in 1969 on personal property and grain and for per capita school taxes.

* The original fiscal note dated January 23, 1969, showed payment to County Treasurer of \$20,500,000.00 but this had not been adjusted for an estimated \$1,600,000.00 of taxes on improvements on leased sites which were taxed as personal property through 1967 but since then have been assessed and taxed as real estate.
