THIS PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SB2227 WOULD INCREASE MY ORIGINAL FISCAL NOTE BY A GREAT AMOUNT. FOR ALL PRACTICAL PURPOSES IT WOULD DESTROY CENTRAL DUPLICATING SERVICE. THE YEAR 1970 WE DUPLICATED 8 MILLION COPIES AT A COST OF \$43,000.00-WE COLLATED 3 MILLION SHEETS AT A COST OF \$5,500.00-WE FOLDED 306 THOUSAND SHEETS AT A COST OF \$268.00-WE PLASTIC BOUND 51,200 BOOKLETS AT A COST OF \$4,464.00-WE STAPLED 39 THOUSAND COPIES AT A COST OF \$110.00-AND WE DRILLED 539 THOUSAND HOLES AT A COST OF \$164.00.

THE GREATER PORTION OF THIS TOTAL COST OF \$54,000.00 WOULD HAVE TO BE SENT TO COMMERCIAL PRINTERS AND IT WOULD FALL INTO THE SMALLER QUANTITY BRACKETS. THIS COST WOULD BE 10 TO 20 TIMES HIGHER THAN THE STATE'S CENTRAL DUPLICATING SERVICE.

CONSERVATIVELY, THIS COST COULD REACH 1½ MILLION DOLLARS THE NEXT BIANNIUM FOR CENTRAL DUPLICATING SERVICE AND THE OTHER DEPARTMENTS LISTED ON THE ORIGINAL FISCAL NOTE WOULD INCREASE PROPORTIONATLY
