

In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

Should the State Planning Division be assigned the responsibility of administering SB 2274, it is anticipated that an additional four professional staff members would have to be added. These four persons would have to be: one attorney, one environmental engineer-ecologist, one geologist and one urban planner. Based upon the staff sizes of other states with similar legislation, it is expected this would be minimum staff size. However, it is my understanding that the Environmental Health and Engineering Services, Division of the State Health Department, currently provides some of the services intended in SB 2274. Following a conversation between Senator Lee Christensen, Mr. Willis Van Heuvelen, Mr. Gene Christianson and myself, it seems possible that the Health Department might be capable of administering this Bill with little or no additional staff.
