In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

Senate Bill 2371 which would transfer the functions of the State Laboratory to the State Department of Health could result in long range fiscal savings. These fiscal savings would occur because of the elimination of unnecessary testing of federally tested products, dual inspection and program duplication. It may also be possible for the Health Department to better utilize federal funds in the operation of the State Laboratories Department. To facilitate the smooth transition it would be desirable for the 1973-1975 biennium to appropriate the executive budget recommendation for the State Laboratories to the State Department of Health if Senate Bill 2371 passes. Savings in administration may be possible in fiscal year 1973-1975.
