The Bureau of Vital Statistics presently does similar work, however, it does not have the supervisory duties over the counties to the extent this bill would place such burdens on the Secretary of State's Office. The Bureau has 16 people working full time and an appropriation of about \$250,000.

Kentucky has a similar registration program. A consulting firm was hired there to implement the voters registration and the cost of implementation was \$750,000.

A cost estimate for this office's participation of \$350,000 does not appear to be too high. If the lists were computerized the costs would be even greater. If all 400,000+ eligible voters registered a computerized list would be undoubtedly necessary.

I am not in a position to estimate the costs of such a program at the county level.
