In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

S.B. 2446 proposes a significant departure from existing law relative to the regulation of day care. Two significant changes in existing law, neither of which will have a fiscal impact, are proposed in the bill. First, day care and foster care are statutorily separated. Secondly, the bill introduces a registration system for family day care as contrasted by the current licensing system.

Included within the executive budget are funds necessary for discharging the Social Service Board's licensing responsibility under existing law. In the event S.B. 2446 is enacted, the funds which would have been necessary for licensing will be utilized in the registration system. Consequently, no fiscal impact in addition to that budgeted for in the executive budget is anticipated.
