We anticipate little or no direct fiscal impact upon this agency as a result of approval of HB1256.

The city of Bismarck proposes to extend Broadway Avenue from 26th Street east through property owned by this agency. The extension will be 80' wide and will divide our property into two parcels.

We have developed an agreement with the city by which it agrees to construct the street improvement, install all necessary driveways and replace our security fencing as a part of the project. In return for the easement, the city will not levy special assessments for this improvement against our property as long as we continue to own it.

The severing of this property by this improvement will cause some inconvenience in our use of it, however, its resale value should not be decreased as a result. The additional street frontage may enhance its value in the long term.
