
This Bill is aimed at increasing the revenues from the licensing of detection and deception examiners, in an attempt to recover the greater percentage of the costs of administering the law.

It is anticipated that this Bill will bring in over the next biennium an additional \$760.00. The current fee schedule brings in approximately \$490.00 per biennium, and the new fee arrangement would bring in approximately \$1,250.00 per biennium.

The expenses of administering this law include: the shared time of Licensing Department personnel. In addition, four law enforcement associated polygraph examiners make up the Attorney General's Ad Hoc Advisory Committee on the licensing of detection and deception examiners. This advisory committee meets approximately five times per biennium to conduct licensing examinations, with a per meeting cost of approximately \$240.00, or at a biennial cost of approximately \$1,200.00.
