Because State Laboratories Department sanitarians currently inspect retail food outlets under the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, the added cost of administering and enforcing SB2072 would be small.

Hearings would be held for promulgating rules as provided by section 7 and the law and rules would be printed for distribution.

The estimated additional cost for administering and enforcing SB2072 is \$3,500 for the period July 1, 1977 to June 30, 1979, and \$3,000 for each subsequent biennium.


