If the compliance deadline date is increased to 1983, there would be potential savings this bienium. Costs could be defrayed over a 6 year period instead of meeting the 1979 deadline. Conversely, based on today's 9% annual increase in construction costs, total costs would greatly increase if defrayed over the longer time limit proposed.

Administration costs will run directly with degree of enforcement. Inspection, travel expenses and clerical could range from \$30,000-\$100,000 annually.


