Senate Bill 2166 does not place direct fiscal liabilities on either the state or its local governments (cities and counties). The legislation outlines the general procedures on which state and local governments can support other jurisdictions outside the state and how they can expect assistance from them.

Should the state or local government request or receive assistance from an outside source, the fiscal liabilities may be paid by the requesting or receiving jurisdiction, or the liabilities may be covered by federal disaster or emergency legislation.

Again, it is the opinion of the sponsoring agency that the bill will not obligate the state or local governments to assist without reimbursement, nor does the bill give state and local officials an additional requirement to utilize their personnel, resource, etc.


