The above line under the current law costs .20. The proposed law would be .24 A 20 % increase.

The above line under the current law costs .30. The proposed law would be .36 A 20 % increase.

Subsequent insertions of either line under the present law costs .13 Proposed .18 A 39 % increase.

25 % of all Legal Notices are published	1	time	a 20 % increase in cost.
35 % of all Legal Notices are published	2	times	a 27 % increase in cost.
37 % of all Legal Notices are published	3	times	a 30 % increase in cost.
3 % of all Legal Notices are published	4	times	a 32 % increase in cost.

Only about 17 % of the Legal Notices are published by the State. The School Boards, The Cities and the Counties would be effected the most by these proposed increases.

The Game and Fish Departments legal notices for 1975-76 cost \$ 44,024.68, under the proposed rates \$ 52,829.42.  
a 20 % increase.

The Public Service Commissions legal notices for 1975-76 cost \$ 7,341.60, under the proposed rates \$ 9,596.08.  
a 30 % increase.

Ballots are published 2 times.

The 1976 Primary and General Election Ballots cost \$ 123,321.99 for publishing them in the official newspapers.  
Under the proposed rates the cost would be ----- \$ 154,892.42. A 25.6 % increase.
