Alcohol beverage taxes for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1976, totalled \$5,506,292.

This is a 6.4% decrease from the previous fiscal year.

The formula set out in this bill would transfer \$825,944 from the alcohol beverage taxes which currently go into the general fund to the special fund as outlined in Senate Bill 2329. This figure is based on the fiscal year total of \$5,506,292.
