

SENATE AMENDMENT to SB NO. 2361

On page 2, line 5, delete the word "sixty" and insert in lieu thereof the word "seventy"

On page 2, after line 24, insert the following new section:

"SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.) Section 57-60-15 of the 1975 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

57-60-15. DUTY OF COUNTY TREASURER - ALLOCATION TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.) Moneys received by counties under the provisions of section 57-60-14 shall be apportioned as follows:

1. ~~((Fifteen))~~ Thirty-five percent of all revenues allocated to any county shall be paid by the county treasurer to the incorporated cities of the county based upon the population of each incorporated city according to the last official ~~((decennial))~~ regular or special federal census ((;)) or the census taken in accordance with the provisions of chapter 40-02 in case of a city incorporated subsequent to such census.
2. ~~((Forty))~~ Thirty-five percent of the revenues allocated to any county shall be deposited by the county treasurer in the county general fund to be used for general governmental purposes ~~((; and))~~.
3. ~~((Forty-five))~~ Thirty percent of all revenues allocated to any county shall be apportioned by the county treasurer to school districts within the county on the average daily ~~((attendance distribution))~~ membership basis, as certified to him by the county superintendent of schools."
