HB 1249 is enabling legislation to permit development and utilization of sources of nonionizing radiation consistent with the protection of health and welfare, prevent injury to plant and animal life and property and to foster the comfort and convenience of the people of this state.

In the next biennium it is anticipated that there will be no significant fiscal impact to the department as a result of passage of this Bill.

It is anticipated that the fee system, authorized under HB 1249 would not be implemented during this biennium, therefore there would be no collections. It is anticipated that it will take approximately two years to develop the reasonable and effective regulations as provided for under this Bill.

In succeeding years the income to the state resulting from collection of fees would support the administration and technical services provided for under this HB 1249.
