In view of the fact that all present retirees under the judicial retirement system receive proportional salary increases along with active judges, and in view of the fact that all respective retirees during the next biennium will be getting one-half the regular salary of an active judge, it appears that this bill would have no fiscal impact during the 1979-81 biennium. It should be noted, however, that this bill would have financial impact in later bienniums but the precise amount cannot be computed at this time.

The appropriation request for the payment of judicial retirement benefits for both the supreme court and district court judges and/or spouses are contained within Senate Bill 2038 and are fully provided for in that bill.
