In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

Senate Bill No. 2229 is estimated to reduce expenditures for Unemployment Compensation by \$851,000.00. (The increase in the minimum WBA from \$15.00 to \$25.00 is estimated to save \$92,000.00. The change in potential duration is expected to save \$759,000.00.) If this premise proves valid it should also reduce the dollar amount of benefits paid to unemployed state government employees. State government employment encompasses 6.56% of total employment covered under North Dakota Unemployment Compensation Law. Using this factor, it is estimated that the enactment of this bill will reduce the amount of benefits paid to unemployed state government workers by \$55,800.00. Since nearly all state government agencies selected the reimbursement method of payment, this would result in a savings of \$55,800.00 to the state.
