

In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

We are unable to locate information from which the number of "locksmiths" doing business in the state can be ascertained or even estimated. Because the occupation is rather obsolete, it would not appear that the number of persons able to qualify for a license would be significant. A blind estimate would be five to ten. Revenues from licensing would then be \$75.00 to \$150.00 per year. Estimated expenses for printing of license applications, licenses, and the duplicate forms prescribed by the Bill are \$200.00. Estimated office time for processing applications, issuing licenses, filing duplicate forms and related clerical, secretarial, and legal functions is 50 hours per year, at an estimated average cost of \$10.00 per hour, or \$500.00. Total estimated expense per year would then be \$700.00, assuming no enforcement activities, such as administrative hearings, investigations, etc., arise.
