In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

This legislation would authorize the restructuring of the boundary lines of county water management districts to allow for the formation of a water management district or districts encompassing a watershed area and would require the election of district officers.

No specific costs for this agency have been assigned to this legislation because our involvement, except for communications and correspondence, will meld reasonably well with our established pattern of contacts with local water management entities. It would be difficult to separate the costs associated with this legislation from the costs of our usual relationship with local entities.

In the "Future Needs" section of our budget, we have indicated increased costs for implementation of water management district programs and have estimated these costs for the next biennium (1983-1985) in the \$100,000 range.
