In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

House Bill 1125 is enabling legislation to permit development and utilization of sources of nonionizing radiation consistent with the protection of health and welfare to prevent injury to plant and animal life and property, and to foster the comfort and convenience of the people of this state.

In the next biennium it is anticipated that there will be no significant fiscal impact in the Department as a result of passage of this bill.

It is anticipated that the fee system authorized under House Bill 1125 would not be implemented during this biennium. Therefore there would be no collections. It is anticipated that it would take approximately two years to develop the reasonable and effective regulations as provided for under this bill.
