In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

- It is estimated that the collection of fees in the next biennium will generate an income of \$36,000 to health department operating fund as provided for in Section 7 of this Bill.  
  
The expenses to the radiation control program with respect to licensing and registration are expected to equal income and would be used to offset increasing costs of providing a service of ionizing radiation protection.
- The implementation of a program to regulate and control uranium mining; processing and related waste disposal as provided for in Sections 1 through 5 of this Bill would cost an estimated \$27,030 in the next biennium. This cost is reflected in the Radiation Control Program program enhancement request of the Executive Budget.
