In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

HB 1628 provides for an unsalaried, fifteen member, statewide outdoor recreation committee to be entitled to fifty dollars per diem for expenses while attending meetings of the committee. Neither the number of meetings per year nor the length of meetings are determined. I will estimate meetings to be called twice per year and to last two days each. The fiscal impact would then be estimated as follows:

$$15 \text{ members} \times \$50/\text{diem} \times 2 \text{ days} \times 2 \text{ meetings/year} = \$3,000/\text{year}$$
