Narrative:

No fiscal effect on the State Auditor's Office since we are now engaged in performance auditing and would incorporate these 5 audits into our audit program. The only exceptions would be the largest departments where we would, as spelled out in Section 4 of the bill, ask the Audit & Fiscal Review Committee to hire an outside firm to perform the audit since we do not have the needed manpower. If this happened, I would assume the Audit & Fiscal Review Committee would need funding to pay for the audit. I would see this happening if they asked for performance audits of the Highway Department, Health Department or the Social Services Department.
