In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

Senate Bill 2327 would provide for military leave pay for 15 days instead of 30 as now provided by law, and would provide for payment of an amount equal to the difference between their military pay and their regular salary, whereas current law allows employees their regular salary and their pay from the military.

The net savings to the state would be approximately \$40,000 per year.
