Narrative:

If this bill passes, it would result in a savings of about \$62,000 for salaries, operating expense, and equipment. However, I would like to point out that with the Crime Victims Appropriations bill, SB 2038, there would have to be some provisions made for on-going administrative costs in phasing out the claimants who are presently on their rolls. The on-going liabilities could continue for several years.
