Narrative:

The provisions of House Bill No. 1061 allow for the establishment of an operating fund to be used by the State Auditors office. All moneys currently collected by the State Auditor for auditing services would be deposited into this operating fund rather than into the State General Fund as specified under current law.

The fiscal impact on the State General Fund is that anticipated collections from audit services estimated at \$765,000 for the 1983-85 biennium would be deposited in this operating account and not in the State General Fund. There would be no fiscal impact on other funds.
