Narrative:

Presently, residents 65 years or older or residents who are totally or permanently disabled qualify for a \$2.00 fishing license. Grafton State School patients, State Industrial School students, School for the Deaf students, School for the Blind students, State Hospital patients, and Community Mental Health and Retardation Service Unit patients under direct therapeutic care may fish without a resident fishing license.

Since this bill would probably affect a very small number of people, most of whom presently pay \$2.00 for a license, the fiscal effect will be quite small. Game and Fish Department revenue will probably be decreased by \$500 or less per year.
