Narrative:

The purpose of House Bill 1189 is to eliminate duplication of enforcement duties, the elimination of supervisory positions, and to transfer Truck Regulatory functions to the Highway Patrol. In transferring the employees of the Highway Department to the Highway Patrol, the funds necessary for this transfer would be transferred from the State Highway Fund. The purpose of transferring expenses of the Truck Regulatory functions is to defray the expenses incurred within the Highway Patrol.

At the present time, a study resolution is being drawn up to determine what costs, if any, would be associated to the retirement system. An accurate figure cannot be given at this time.
