Narrative:

House Bill No. 1198 as amended would establish an abandoned well site reclamation fund. Revenue for the fund would come primarily from fees collected by the Oil & Gas Division of the Industrial Commission and money received from forfeitures of drilling and reclamation bonds.

Fees collected by the Oil and Gas Division are currently deposited in the General Fund. The maximum effect on the General Fund would be a revenue reduction of \$150,000.
