Narrative:

It is impossible to determine the fiscal impact as it relates to the disposal of articles within the Historical Society collections without an analysis of which items will possibly be considered. Since the bill would provide for "disposal by appropriate means including but not limited to sale or exchange," there may well be many cases where items produce no income. There is a dual problem of determining which items will be disposed of and what method of disposal will be used. Until these problems are resolved, the fiscal impact to the special fund of revenue and possible expenditures is unknown.
