Narrative:

If HB 1237 is passed into law, the potential fiscal impact to the state general fund is inestimable and unlimited. The Workmen's Compensation Bureau would promulgate rates based on its best judgment, but if those rates were inadequate to meet the losses experienced, the excess of losses over premiums would become general obligations of the State of North Dakota.

Counties and cities would experience increased workmen's compensation premiums for workers mandatorily covered, that are nonoptional.
