This bill reclassifies platted land that presently is in the commercial classification and values it the same as agricultural property. If this bill is enacted, the effect would be to reduce the property tax revenues to counties and cities because of the lower agricultural values that would apply to "platted land."

The present classification system does not [redacted] identify properties which would be affected by enacting this bill, therefore, we cannot estimate the amount of fiscal impact.


