Narrative:

If this bill is passed, no more than three judges would serve on the Nominating Committee. Assuming that three district judges would serve on that Committee and would attend two meetings per year, the total biennial expense for such attendance would equal \$2,400. It is assumed that this sum of money would be available in the appropriation to the Judicial Branch (S.B. 2038). It is not possible to estimate the cost of attendance of non-judge members at the meetings of the committee, but it is felt that the expense would be minimal as most members would be located in the vicinity with their cost being underwritten by the respective counties.
