Narrative:

In general, this proposed legislation will only affect non-coal producing counties that receive money from another county that is a coal producing county that has a tippel 10 miles from the non-coal producing county. Currently, present law provides that the county treasurer apportion revenues to non-coal producing counties within 15 miles of a coal producing county tippel. According to information provided this office, only Dunn, Morton, and Divide counties are involved by this statutory provision.

The state fiscal effect of this legislation is less than \$5,000 since the responsibility of the State Treasurer is to distribute only to the counties where coal is severed. Distribution within the counties is currently the responsibility of the particular county treasurer involved. Any fiscal impact to the county and city shares is unknown to this office and should be addressed at the local county level where the responsibility for distributing the coal severance revenue within the county and its political subdivisions currently exists.

State Fiscal Effect: Estimated to be less than \$5,000.
