Narrative:

There are two known pipelines that will become subject to assessment and tax if HB 1596 passes. These two pipelines would be subject to a 1983 property tax of approximately \$253,000 of which the counties share is \$61,000, the state and other political subdivisions receiving the balance, and a 1984 property tax of \$232,000 with the counties receiving \$56,000, the balance going to the state and other political subdivisions. There are presumably additional pipelines which are presently not assessed that would become taxable but the location and valuation of these additional pipelines are not presently known.

The one-mill state medical center levy is the state special fund that is affected by this bill, but the impact is less than \$5,000 for the biennium.
