Narrative:

The bill asks that the secretary of state's office remain open on Saturdays so that someone can call or come into the office to check Uniform Commercial Code (U.C.C.) filings against a farming operation. This is requested in case a farm auction takes place on a Saturday and someone needs to know if any U.C.C. filings have been made against the farm. Surely, any auctioneer who knows his business would be able to check the U.C.C. filings any business day before the auction. Very few calls or office visits are expected. Another problem would be to collect for financial information given out over the phone. Our U.C.C. division currently does not give U.C.C. information over the phone because of the collection problem.

To meet the requirements of the proposed bill would require an additional State Fiscal Effect: persons salary, fringe benefits, and operating expenses.
