Narrative:

House Bill 1698 would establish a comprehensive royalty collection and auditing system for state and private lands. The fiscal impact of the bill is difficult to predict. The bill appears to require the Commission to collect and audit royalties from all state and private lands. The cost for such a comprehensive royalty management system would probably exceed \$1,000,000 for each year of the biennium. A limited royalty management system could be established at a significantly lower cost, depending on the number of leases to be audited.
