Narrative:

HB 1707, if enacted into law, would increase revenues to the State General Fund \$96,000,000 to \$105,000,000 and increase revenues to the Motor Vehicle Registration Fund \$850,000 to \$950,000 during the 1983-85 biennium. HB 1707 would also increase revenues to the State General Fund \$850,000 to \$950,000 and increase revenues to the Motor Vehicle Registration Fund \$70,000 to \$80,000 during the current biennium.
