In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative:

It is estimated that SB 2067, as amended, will generate approximately \$2,901,345 during the 1983-85 biennium, or \$625,600 more than the present gaming tax generates.

Under the provisions of SB 2067, as amended, cities and counties will receive \$933,325, and the state general fund will receive \$1,968,020. The State's portion will be \$307,700 less than the present 5% tax would have generated.
