Narrative:

It is estimated that SB 2067, as amended, will generate approximately \$2,798,256 during the 1983-85 biennium, or \$362,800 more than the present gaming tax generates.

Under the provisions of SB 2067, as amended, cities and counties will receive \$1,022,680, and the state general fund will receive \$1,775,576. The State's portion will be \$659,880 less than the present 5% tax would have generated.
