In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative: It is estimated that engrossed SB 2067, as amended, will generate approximately \$2,579,550 during the 1983-85 biennium, or \$144,100 more than the present tax generates.

Under the provisions of engrossed SB 2067, as amended, this revenue will be deposited in the state gaming enforcement fund with \$1,002,550 being distributed to cities and counties, and \$1,577,000 remaining in the fund. The State's portion will be \$858,450 less than the present 5% tax would have generated.
