It is estimated that engrossed SB 2067, as amended, will generate approximately \$2,435,450 during the 1983-85 biennium.

Under the provisions of SB 2067, as amended, the cities and counties will receive \$975,450 of the tax proceeds, and the remainder, \$1,460,000, will go to the State general fund.
