Narrative:

Pursuant to North Dakota Century Code section 11-15-07, subdivision 5, the sheriff of a county is entitled to receive \$7.50 for service of a subpoena. Pursuant to North Dakota Century Code section 31-01-16, witnesses are entitled to receive as reimbursement the sum of \$15/day plus reimbursement for mileage and travel expenses at the rates allowed for state employees. The fiscal impact of SB 2124 on the office of Attorney General would appear to be less than \$100 per year.
