Narrative:

MAN 3 1983

This bill would permit the department, by rule, to set fees for various certified copies of certificates or records. The present statute has a prescribed fee, not to exceed two dollars, to be paid for certified copies. It is anticipated that the department would set the fee at five dollars which would more closely represent the costs of carrying out the vital records activities. The estimated additional income is approximately \$150,000 per year or \$300,000 for the biennium.
