Narrative:

This bill would permit the Department, by rule, to set and collect reasonable fees for the issuance of permits or registration certificates for registering, licensing, or permitting solid waste generators, transporters, and treatment storage recycling or disposal facilities. The collected fees are to offset estimated loss of federal funds in the next biennium in the amount of \$20,000 per year or \$40,000 for the biennium. Fiscal impact upon 68 cities which represents approximately 33 percent of program effort is estimated to be \$6,500 per year or \$13,000 for the biennium. This user fee would allow the Department to continue present level of effort without requesting an increase in general fund monies to offset loss of federal funds.
